Make a trophy, statue, or medal that would be worthy of giving your history maker (must include a speech giving reasons why they deserve it). Give the award a name.	Dress like the person and act out a scene from his/her life (see teacher with ideas to get approval before presentation day).
Poster with images or drawings (must include 5 or more facts and pictures).	Make an item that reminds you of the history maker. This must be hand made and you will need to explain why you chose that item.	Create a journal with 3-5 entries from the point of view of your history maker. Be sure to date the entries and include events and feelings.
Make a video (must be at least 30 seconds). This could include interviews of people's views on your history maker.	Write a poem about your history maker (must be 12 lines or longer).	Make a mini scrapbook as though you were the history maker. Include at least 5 pages with pictures.
